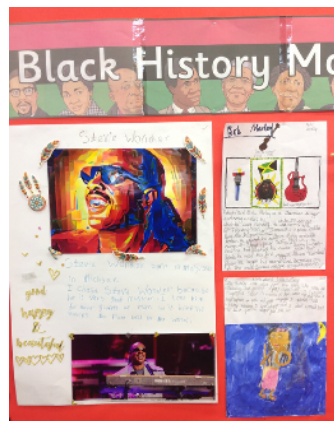
Black History Month

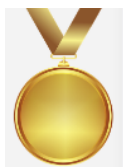
