Lots of parents ask us how to help their children to develop their language. All the research tells us that the best (and easiest!) thing you can do is talk to your child from the minute they are born. We will post regular tips in this newsletter and the first one is here:

How often you interact with your child and the way you interact with your child can make a huge difference. By following these simple guidelines, you will set your young child on the path towards language learning: **Be face-to-face** - one of the best ways to let your child know that you want to talk to them is to be face-to-face. This means joining your child at their physical level, whether that's on the floor together, facing them in their high chair, or sitting together at the table. Make eye contact with your child and let them know that you are listening and
